God has blessed the work in Pakistan and Adam's ministry flourished as thousands of Muslims encountered the power of God through Jesus Christ.

In the Kingdom of God it is hard to draw a straight line of cause and effect, but the Scriptures are clear about the power of prayer. Tonia remarked, "Through the years God has opened doors for deeper partnership. What began as a journey in prayer for a people group I could not picture became the journey of a lifetime."

"I excitedly attended my first Urbana missions conference in 1996. Each of us in attendance was assigned an unreached people group to pray for.

I was given the Bhanjalari (name changed) of Pakistan, for whom I began to pray faithfully," Tonia related. "I felt deeply connected to that people group through prayer.

"As I learned more about the Bhanjalari, I wondered what God might be asking of me and thought that I might go as a missionary with the Christian and Missionary Alliance (CMA). But then I unexpectedly met Scott, the man that God wanted to be my husband! We got married and shared the burden for the Bhanjalari people together, but I was confused about what the Lord wanted for the next steps.

"Once there I heard that someone had come from a tribe in Pakistan. I excitedly arranged to meet Kevin (GT) and Adam. I cannot describe my joy and shock when I learned that Adam was Bhanjalari! Thirteen years after I began praying, I met a one of the first Bhanjalari believers!"

Tonia listened intently to Adam's testimony of how he had put his faith in Christ and through him how his whole family had come to faith. As he talked of persecution, miracles and God's intervention through dreams, Tonia understood that the Spirit of God had used her years of prayers in ways she had never dreamed.

Scott and Tonia built a lasting relationship with Adam, investing not only in prayer, but in finances and in a visit to Adam's home in 2016.

# TRIVIA

**Q:** What do Global Teams, a renowned British Bible translator, an American missionary to Turkey with CRU, and a Bengali college student have in common?

**A:** They are cooperating to make the Scriptures available to hundreds of thousands of Bengali speaking Muslims and Christians.

According to our reports, last year more than 82,000 Bengali speaking Muslims families were baptized into new life in Christ Jesus. The explosive growth of the Church among Bengali speaking Muslims has far outpaced our ability to get printed scriptures into the hands of all those who want them. While governments crack down on the printing and distribution of the Bible, technology allows us to access even remote villages.

Global Teams initiated a partnership to deliver the Scriptures electronically in three ways:

1. Through text messages delivered to rural speakers without smart phones or internet.
2. For those with internet, web-based audio scriptures with text that can be viewed in real time or downloaded for offline use.
3. Micro SD cards for distribution by evangelism and teaching teams.

None of these are groundbreaking in and of themselves, but A.I. allows us to develop these materials in ways that protect the anonymity of those reading the texts and deliver them through more secure avenues.

It's well known that people who go on a short-term mission to a location are more likely to return to that place long term. They build relationships of significance, and that fuels their sense of calling. Of course, logistically this means that they usually land in a place with an abundance of missionaries and local churches. This is an obstacle for engaging the unreached where there are few missionaries available to receive teams. The unreached live in places that present many challenges for visitors.
