




In the last 125 years, a powerful move of the Holy Spirit has dramatically shifted the locus of Christianity from the West to the Majority World.

Over that period, the percentage of Christians in the Majority World has risen from less than 7% to more than 67% today. This is astounding!



This redistribution of Christians has led some churches and donors in the West to conclude that they should stop sending their own expensive missionaries, investing instead in national missionaries who can do the job more economically.

This way of thinking sets aside the personal responsibility of every believer, no matter where they live, to obey the command of Jesus to make disciples of all nations. A visiting African brother commented, "Americans prefer to give money rather than getting their hands dirty in the work of mission." While our roles in world evangelism need to change, North Americans must reject false humility and stay in the fray of world evangelization.

African churches, Latin American believers, and Asian leaders have exponentially enhanced the expression and gifts of Christ's Body worldwide. And Western believers must continue to add their unique leaven to that expression. We are better together.

North American believers, no longer the majority, must contribute their unique gifts. Our mission models are still catching up with the move of God. With 85% of our field partners being sent from Majority World churches, Global Teams reflects well the distribution of God's people. This kind of partnership is messy, however. The mixture of differing cultures, languages, expectations, and economic conditions can make it challenging to work together. But the powerful outcomes we are experiencing demonstrate that the effort is worthwhile. It takes all of the global Church working together to reach the ends of the earth.

John and Vi joined Global Teams with a desire to make a difference in the lives of those without the Gospel. Given their age and professional experience, they didn't know if they would be "good missionaries" or even be able to learn the language. But they were willing to use what they had, learn from others, love people, and follow the Holy Spirit's leading.

Fifteen years into the adventure, they have brought clean water to more than 400 villages in the Himalayas and been part of seeing dozens of house fellowships begin. John and Vi are quick to add that this impact is only possible by partnering with and equipping local believers with GT principles to go into remote areas. John and Vi's clean water initiatives have opened access to remote parts of the country their local partners would not have attempted to enter.

"South Asian Christians think they are too poor, too small, too uneducated to do anything," they observed, "but God has put much fire and passion for Him in their hearts, and the Church grows by leaps and bounds when they choose to put whatever they have - themselves - into God's hands for His use and glory."

John and Vi met "Prem" and "Laxmi" in one of their trainings. Their village had been decimated by a monsoon, and they were all forced to rebuild their lives in a new location. But after six years, they still did not have electricity or a source of water.

Laxmi and her three children carried water daily to their home, but they often became sick from the easily contaminated water.

Nearby Christ followers, also living in difficult situations, reached out with empathy to this family, teaching them how to treat their water and the water of their neighbors, making it safe to drink. Through these acts of kindness, Prem and Laxmi became disciples of Jesus! Later, John and his partners returned to drill a shallow well that supplied more families with life-sustaining water. Laxmi is filled with gratitude and hope.

Their field partner in the area writes, "Laxmi is making chlorine for her family and for her neighbors who are coming to her after seeing what God did in her family last year. Now, praise God, one church has started in her village and she is also leading a small group!"

John and Vi's faith, expressed in practical love, opened the doors for the Gospel in hundreds of villages. Their partnership with local believers provided training to mobilize field partners to walk through those doors. Their example illustrates the partnerships Global Teams aims to create, capitalizing on the gifts each brings to the task of reaching the least reached with the Gospel of Living Water.
